Essex is best described as a parallelogram of contrasts, from the industrial south-east border with London to the agricultural north, and the wild and often treacherous coastline along its eastern encounter with the North Sea. Pevsner wrote that the Essex variety of character 'must be given precedence over many larger counties', and so it must. It was here that Julius Caesar founded his capital, Camulodunum (Colchester), in the first century ad. William the Conqueror ruled his new domain from Barking Abbey and in the 16th century, at Tilbury, Elizabeth I rallied her troops as they awaited the Spanish Armada. Along with a plethora of fascinating facts and figures, customs and curiosities, meet an 18th-century parson's wife who eloped with an Earl's son (both 'husbands' attended her funeral), an Ongar man who sold his wife to the highest bidder, and a husband who stayed silent for seven years in penance for wrongfully accusing his wife of adultery.
