In this lively account of Arizona's Rim Country War in the 1880s sometimes called the Pleasant Valley War historian Daniel Justin Herman explores a web of conflict involving Mormons, Texas cowboys, New Mexican shepherders, Jewish merchants, and mixed-blood ranchers.
